

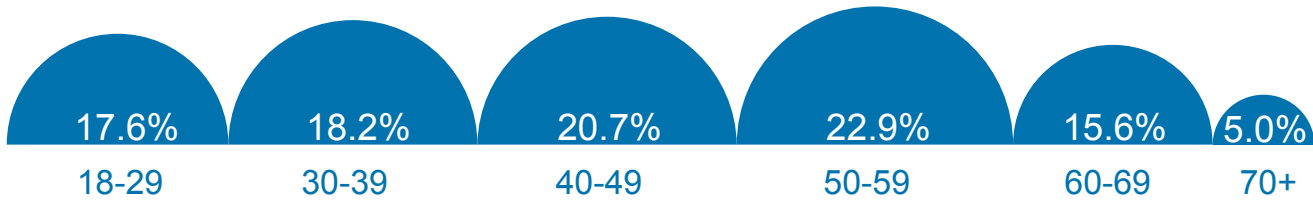
# Your OHS Community

The OHS has over 225,000 participants over the age of 18. That’s more people than the entire City of Kitchener!

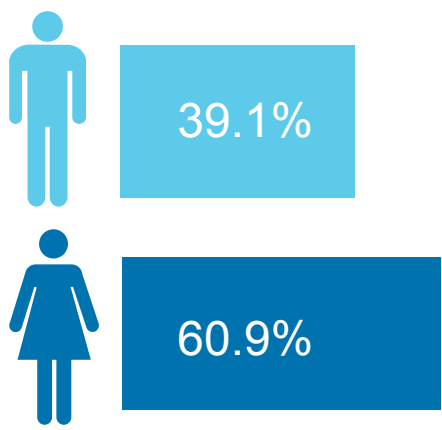

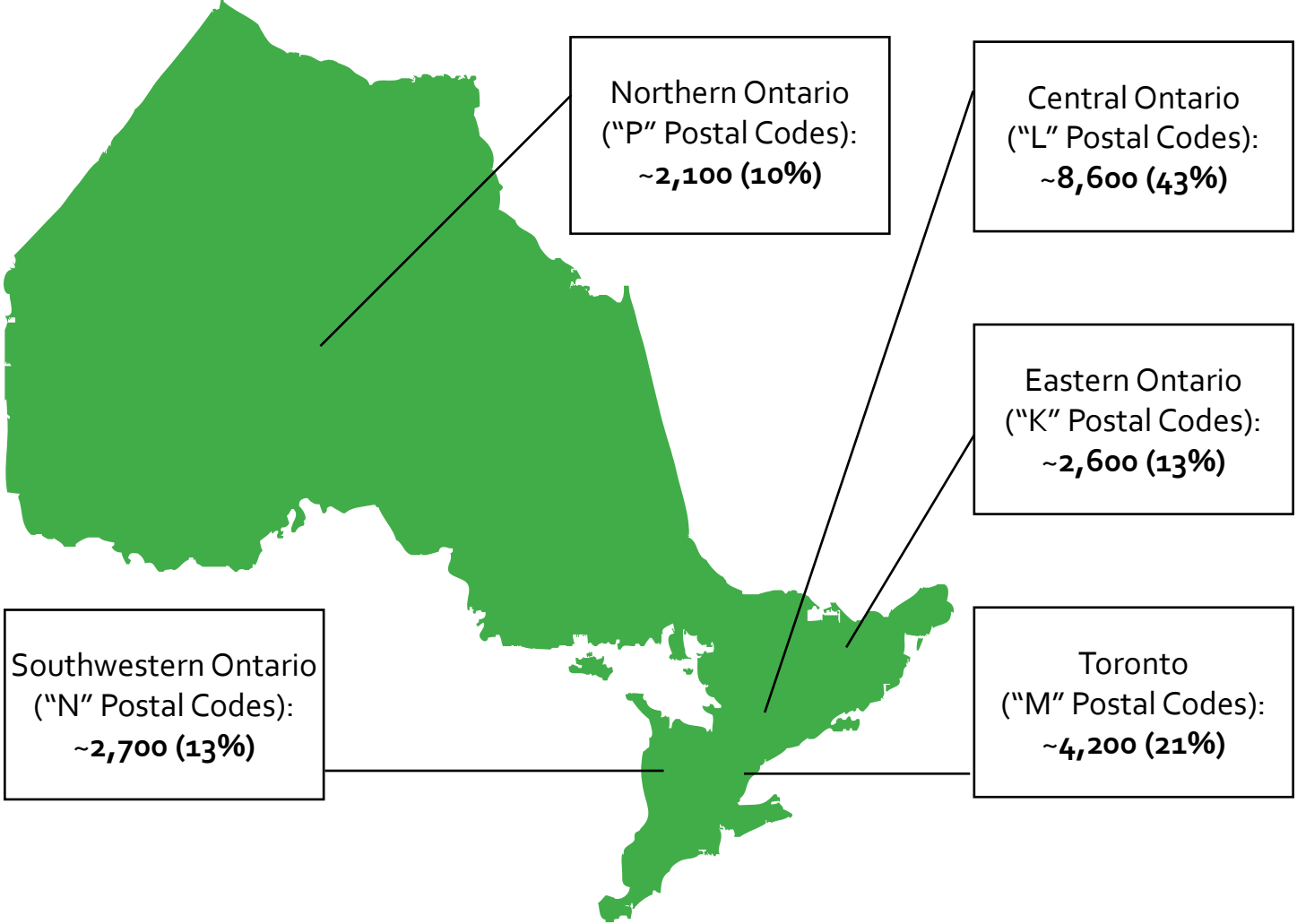
